Blue Star Mothers of America, Inc., New York Chapter # 1 – " Pride of Ontario County" would like to give you a brief overview of the Blue Star Canteen and what we do to aid our soldiers and veterans in New York State. The Blue Star Canteen is now seven years old. It is located on the grounds of the Canandaigua, New York, Veterans Administration Hospital outside of Rochester, New York in the Finger Lakes Region. It is the only canteen in the nation since the end of the Korean War and we are very proud of it. We lease the 130 year old white farmhouse from the VA. We had to go to the Director of Veterans Affairs in Washington, D.C. to get permission to do this but our VA Director, Craig Howard, believed in our idea and got us all the support that we needed. Our Grand Opening was in September of 2007. More recently, we had a full scale redo of the house by The Home Depot, nearly all of whom were veterans. It looks incredible and we are very proud of it. We finally have a weather safe front porch and a very unique mural over the inside front door. We bring in a hot meal twice a week for the vets and we also bring in food for the Poker Runs that are held by various motorcycle groups who, in turn, support our endeavors. As a result, we figure we serve about 4500 meals in the course of a year. We also run a clothing closet with newer used clothing, shoes, etc. We were able to support 200 homeless veterans recently at a Military Stand Down, in the city of Rochester, with clothing, two meals, snack bags and comfort bags. We were recently able to supply an additional 70 comfort bags for the Veterans Outreach Center Homeless Program. We also have a food pantry. This is for vets who are moving out on their own and need some food to tide them over till they get their financial support and food stamps to get their own groceries. Our Chapter is proud to do all this and more for our military past and present. This is Mama's house.

**May 9<sup>th</sup>** was the Pines of Peace Poker Run at American Legion Post #428 in Ontario. In spite of the heat that day, we had a great time. The food, as always, was fabulous. There was enough leftover food for the Pines of Peace patients. The Riders generously donated \$200.00 to BSMA NY#1 for their help. Over \$1,000 was donated to Pines of Peace from the American Legion Post.

I just want the Blue Star Mothers, Chapter #1, to know how amazing I think you are. The food provided was some of the best I have ever had and the DESSERTS were awesome!!! The support given to the Ontario Legion was very much appreciated and it helped their first poker run

be a huge success. Again, thank you from Pines of Peace!

The bench and garden was installed the evening of Wednesday, **May 27**<sup>th</sup>. There are planter pots which have two miniature pine trees in them. The Girl Scouts also planted annuals in our stars next to the bench as well as placed paving stones that they made for us.
